Basic Definitions of the Nine Gifts

Three revelation Gifts:

A word of wisdom is a supernatural revelation from God given at a specific moment to reveal the will of God for a specific situation.

A word of knowledge is a supernatural revelation of facts pertaining to a person or situation, not learned through the natural mind, but is a fragment of knowledge given freely by God for a specific purpose, usually having to do with an immediate need.

Discerning of spirits is the ability to perceive or discern the spirit world, and especially to detect the true source of circumstances or motives of people.

Three power gifts:

The gift of Faith is a unique form of faith that goes beyond natural faith and saving faith. It is a supernaturally surge of confidence from the Spirit of God where an individual receives a trust and does not doubt in regard to a specific matter.

Gifts of healing are the supernatural manifestation of the Holy Spirit given by God for the removing of sickness and disease.

The plural suggests that there are many sicknesses and diseases and all can be healed.

Working of miracles is a manifestation of power beyond the ordinary course of natural law.

Three gifts of inspiration or communications:

Prophecy is a divine disclosure by the spirit to communicate a message from God for a specific moment promoting encouragement or comfort.

Different kinds of tongues is the gift of speaking supernaturally in a language not known to the individual.

Interpretation of tongues is the gift of rendering the message of the Spirit meaningfully to others. It is not the translation of a foreign language but a dynamic equivalent of that which was spoken in tongues.
